The 2<sup>nd</sup> June Grand Opening Event is intended to be a real celebration of the Society's first 50 years as well as the Queen's Jubilee and the start of our month of events. There will be various activities for both children and adults until about 7pm, then the buffet, followed by music and dancing with the disco and live band.
