Welcome to the June edition of the WM. May has been eventful and positive with a Bank Holiday that was warm and sunny and the news that reasoned argument against the Lodge Farm Plan had convinced the Inspector that it was unsound and that it needed to be removed in order for the Local Plan itself to be found sound. Thanks are due to the SALFV team and everyone who supported their campaign!!

What a shame that RBC tried to push Lodge Farm through disregarding the thousands of representations against it, many of which highlighted the factors identified by the Inspector. The change to include Lodge Farm delayed adoption of Rugby's Local Plan by at least a year and cost a great deal in professional fees to ensure the arguments against were properly heard. Let us hope that some searching questions are asked of those responsible and lessons learnt so that scarce resources are not wasted.

The 3rd June is our Big Lunch a great opportunity to toast a battle won!! it is also the closing date for submitting your response to the Neighbourhood Plan Survey. The plan for our Parish will only be as good as the input we put into it so do complete yours.
