- Minutes on the proposition of Councillor Belgrove seconded by Councillor Hallam the minutes of the meeting on 13 August 2013 were approved as a true record and signed by the Chairperson and Clerk.
- 5. RBC Councillor R Hazelton update on issues
 - 5.1 R13/1567 Barn at Manor Farm Parish Council advised that Planning permission was being recommended for approval to the Planning Committee.

5.2 Boundary Stone - awaiting uplift and re-siting.

- 5.3 <u>Mile Stone</u> cannot be located at Dunchurch Highways Depot and is now unlikely to be replaced.
- 5.4 <u>Council Houses</u> Councillor Hazelton advised that it is important that local people (including relatives) who wish to be considered for Council houses have their names on the waiting list in order to be considered when local housing becomes available.
- 5.5 <u>Hanging Baskets</u> Parish Council needs to contact the Parks Department of RBC if they require planted hanging baskets similar to those in Rugby and Dunchurch.
- 5.6 <u>A45 Rubbish</u> RBC Councillor R Hazelton to request clean up of the verges on the A45 within the Willoughby area.
- PLANNING R13/1567 Conversion of Barn to 1 No: dwelling house and the erection of an associated detached Garage – amended scheme to that approved under planning permission R12/1620 – see 5.1 above.
- 7. 7.1 Village Pond nothing to add
 - 7.2 Playing Field
 - 7.2.1. <u>Transfer of Land</u> Council has confirmed to Mrs Brailsford (by Solicitor) that rights of way on land to be transferred will be as at present with no vehicle access past the entrance to the Playing Field. Fencing around perimeter to be sheep netting fencing with round posts to be in keeping with existing fencing.
 - 7.2.2 <u>Swings</u> Councillor T Thomas to obtain price for an amount of Bark Chippings to fill in areas around the Swings.
 - 7.2.3 Safety Inspection completed on 18 September 2013 report awaited.

7.2.4. <u>Hedges</u> – Councillor M Thomas to approach Mr D Thomas of Flecknoe with a view to trimming back the Playing Field hedge,

Playing Field on both sides if possible.

Councillor T Thomas to obtain a bag of tarmac to repair a hole in the Shrubbery footpath.

- 7.3.4. <u>Brook Vegetation</u> Councillor M Thomas has raised with the Highways Department the need to clear the Brook of vegetation on the stretch between Barberry Cottage and the Box Bridge.
- 7.3.5. Rugby Borough Councillor R Hazelton to be advised of "Fly Tipping" at Fox Covert.

- 7.4.2. Suggested layouts were examined by Councillors for 12 plots each plot having a dimension of 14 x 10.67 metres.
