<u>Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 14 October 2014 in the Village</u> <u>Hall at 7.30 pm</u>

1. <u>Apologies:</u> None received

2. <u>Declaration of Interests -</u> None

3. <u>Questions from the Public</u>

3.1 Mr R Williams raised his Planning Application R141143 - proposal to demolish three existing farm buildings and erect a new livestock barn with linked workshop building at Gate Farm, London Road. The Chairperson informed Mr Williams that the Councillors had been circulated with the plans prior to the meeting and no objections from the Parish Council will be made.

4. <u>Minutes</u> on the proposition of Councillor Belgrove seconded by Councillor Settle the minutes of the meeting on 9 September 2014 were approved as a true record and signed by the Chairperson and Clerk.

5.1 <u>County Councillor H Roberts</u>

5.1.1. Fire & Rescue Service — CC H Roberts reported that the target for the Fire & Rescue Service response times has been reduced from 20 to 10 minutes for the rural areas.

5.1.2. <u>Locality Officer WCC</u> — CC H Roberts said that Mr Greg Lawrence had been appointed as Locality Officer for WCC to replace Mr P Manhood. He could be reached on Mr P Manhood's old Mobile Number.

CC H Roberts requested that he be copied with any E-mails to the WCC Highways Department

5.13. <u>**1.5 Tonne Limit — Willoughby</u>** — CC H Roberts continues to pursue the legal introduction of the 7.5 tonne limit through Willoughby and up Longdown Lane. 5.2 <u>**Rugby Borough Councillor R Hazelton**</u></u>

5.2.1. <u>Mile Stones</u> — RBC R Hazelton stated that there had been no progress on the location of the missing Mile Stones.

5.2.2. **Boundary Stones** — Councillor B Hallam and the Clerk agreed to again walk the Village boundary and record the number of Boundary Stones still in existence, their location and the possibility of uplift for renovation.

5.2.3. <u>Mobile Phones/Broadband</u> - No progress as yet despite the help of J Wright M.P. corresponding with the Department of Culture, Media & Sport

5.3 1. <u>Fox Covert</u> — Councillor M Thomas to correspond with CC H Roberts regarding the Council's request for action on repairing the breaking up of the corner opposite Fox Covert.

5_3.2. <u>Gate Farm Flooding</u> — Mr B Williams asked to forward photographic evidence to CC H Roberts regarding the flooding at the front of Gate Farm.

County Councillor H Roberts and Rugby Borough Councillor R Hazelton left the meeting.

6. <u>Matters Arising from the Minutes</u>

6.1 <u>Dunchmeh Division Locality Plan</u> - Clerk confirmed that Rugby Borough Council had been made aware of the allotment site and extension to the Playing Field not detailed on the Plans.

6.2 <u>Village Pond</u> - A working party is still required to clean up the areas around the Village Pond.

6.3 <u>Playing Field</u> - Modem Plant had carried out a survey to establish the work required on the Playing Field extension to bring it up to an acceptable standard with suitable drainage. Chairperson to contact Modem Plant for an estimate for suggested work.

6.4 <u>Playing Field Deeds</u> - No progress from Lloyds Bank as yet - Clerk to follow up.

6.5 <u>Public Rights of Way</u> - Council has confirmed that it is the responsibility of WCC to ensure that any Public Rights of Way are in a condition to be used it is also the responsibility of land owners to ensure that land up to any Public Rights of Way and the entrances to the footpaths are kept clear and in good condition.

6.6. <u>Tree Preservation Order</u> - Mr D Gower of Rugby Borough Council is to confirm with Mr Steam that the two Walnuts and an Ash Tree on his land can have TPO orders placed on them. Mr Gower has also been requested to look at the trees on Brickhill Lane on the Dunchurch side.

6.7. <u>WiFi in Village Hall</u> - The Parish Council understands that the main user of the WiFi facility in the Village Hall is the Willoughby Society.

6.8 <u>Mrs Board</u> - The Council believe that a suitable bench in memory of Mr N Board (to be provided by Mrs Board) should be a Hardwood type bench and would need to be approved by the Parish Council prior to suiting. Clerk asked to correspond with Mrs Board to offer advice on possible suppliers.

7.1 R14/1436 Gate Farm - see minute 3.1

7.2 RI411569 Cottage Farm - Planning permission granted for the retention of the stable building and hay-store building. The Parish Council had raised no objections but they have however requested the Planning Officer to look into an additional building at the side of this development.

73 R14/1423 <u>The Lodge</u> - Planning permission granted for the erection of replacement dwelling, substitution of house type approved. R13/2126 to include a single story side extension Parish Council had raised no objections.

8.3 <u>Conservation Issues</u> - Clerk to check with Mr T Thomas prior to his leaving the Village on the provision and planting of a tree outside the Amenity Garden on the
