MAPS

1765 Shows fields, the Glebe and Copyhold.

1833... An estate map relating to George Mallabar

1835 Shows village with early numbering and naming of fields, and the number of estates. There is a separate index giving details of tenants for 1808 and 1839. Worth photographing and more study.

1835 ... A large map showing all fields named.

1856 .. Fields

1932 ... plus index and information of land sales up to 1952/53.

There are also architectural drawings relating to the church dated 1843 showing ground plans, elevations, the bell tower, details of pews, free seating, and a plan for re-pewing.

DEEDS there are 520 deeds dating from 1200.

We each looked at different volumes of the deeds and selected a few that we thought might be interesting.

I looked at volume 1 1200 - 1299

124 .. Circa 1200 Money supplied for a priest to pray for Gilbert Mowrey and Ralph Saygras

128 .. Circa 1220 / 30 Grant of land from Ralph de Wilebi to his brother Richard of the messuage I Wilebi and 2 acres of land and fields.

130 .. Circa 1230/40 Grant from Yvo Wygen to the Hospital of St John Oxford of all the lands given to the hospital by Roger de Wilebi.

146 .. Circa 1240/50 Copy of deed by which Henry de Leukenore, Chaplain Warden of St John Oxford binds himself and successors to provide a Chaplain in the Chantry of Wyloby to celebrate perpetual prayers for the souls of Sir Stephen de Segrave Sir Gilbert and their ancestors and heirs, and also that five poor men shall have a daily exhibition at the table in the house of the Hospital at Wyloby.

Volume 2 1300 /1566

598 ... October 15th 1418 Certificate by Waiter Bullock, Licentiate in Law, Canon of Lichfield, and Vicar General for John, Bishop of Coventry, that the Master and brethren of the Hospital of St. John have produced documents establishing their right to the possession of the church at Willuby.

611 .. July 5th 1456 at Southam. Certificate by Reginald [Butler] Bishop of Coventry and Lichfield that the Master and brethren of St John Oxon have sufficiently established by the production of their monuments their rights to the appropriation of the parish church of Willuby.

613 .. May 12th 1460 Release from John, Duke of Norfolk to Will. Tybard Pres. Of Magd. Coll and the scholars of the same of all of his rights in the Manor of Willoughby

629 .. November 20th 1554 Deed of sale by Thomas Clarke to Mag. College for £20.00 his messuage called The White House with all its lands.

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
